



**Report of the Water Commissioners of
The North Raynham Water District
May 16,2024**

**To the Citizens of the North Raynham Water District
The Commissioners of the North Raynham Water District respectfully submit the
following report of the operation and financial statement.**

Zero new services were installed giving the district 1429 active services.

The District pumped a total of 119.179 million gallons of water during 2023

The Treasurer's report shows the district to be in sound financial condition. This has been confirmed by the independent auditor's report from Marcum Accountants LLP for the Fiscal Year 2023.

The System Development and the District's Money Market Accounts, Certificates of Deposits and Capital Savings Accounts have yielded a total of \$56,900.00 in interest for Fiscal Year 2023.

The Demand Fees for new water installations generated \$47,260.00 for the Fiscal Year 2023. The System Development Fees generated \$53,975.00 for the Fiscal Year 2023.

District Annual Water Quality Reports

The annual water quality reports will be mailed to each resident by the required Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) July 1st deadline.

Major Infrastructure Changes

The district is continuing to move forward with a major water main upgrade on the west side of Britton Street to King Philip Street in anticipation of a new water filtration plant. The district has applied for an ARPA grant thru the town and was approved for a total award of 395,000.00 dollars. The application is still in the final approval process.

New Meter Replacement Program

The district is continuing a system wide meter replacement program, installing the new radio read meters. District employees will be going door to door asking residents to allow entry to replace the old-style meters. There is no charge for this change out. **Please call for an appointment @ 508-824-0520.** The District has replaced over 64 meters during 2023 bringing the total number of meters replaced to 1,290 which represent 90.3% of the residential accounts. This increases the accuracy of water readings which helps to reduce the districts unaccounted for water and lowers the tax rate due to more accurate consumption billing
